## The Home Visitor

"Rally The Troops" by Rev. Dr. Jeff Beebe

Rally Day marks the start of the Church's calendar year. It's a day to "rally" the members and friends of OBPC and together, foster a sense of renewed energy and commitment for the upcoming year of Christian Education and Worship. The term "rally" itself, stemming from the French verb "rallier" meaning to regroup, signifies a collective gathering for a common purpose. To rally the troops in military terms, to rally the troops, can be understood as establishing a rally point, a designated location where soldiers can regroup, reorganize and receive further instruction. As a verb, to rally, is to gather or bring together implying action. As an intransitive verb (as Webster's definition provides) means to come together again; to renew an effort.

As a community of faith, OBPC seeks to know God. This is what we mean when we say, *Growing to Know God* in our two-fold mission statement (we will address *Living to Show God* at another time, but I'll briefly offer this: It is difficult to show a God, who we don't know). As Rally Day present, we, the members and friends or Ormond Beach Presbyterian Church, are invited to come together, to **Re-Group**, to **Re-Organize**, so that God might further instruct us and we would **Receive** what He would have us be and what He would have us do.

J.I Packer, in his work, *Knowing God*, presents these challenging words of growth for us:

"Disregard the study of God, and you sentence yourself to stumble and blunder through life blindfolded, as it were, with no sense of direction and no understanding of what surrounds you. This way you can waste your life and lose your soul."

To know God, simply put, is an invitation for you and me to seek the opportunities provided to study God's Word, individually, and along-side others who desire to know God, focusing on what it means to be inwardly strong, so that their living might show God in and though all that they say and all that they do. Friends, it's time to rally the troops!

May the blessing of God the Father, and God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit be upon you this day and every day!




#### TEEN NIGHTS are back
